

Discussion/Reflection Questions

1. Why do you think God wants his people to regularly gather together? What value does it bring to their lives? Which of those reasons happens well on a Sunday morning in a worship service? Which would better happen in some other type of environment?
2. Think of a time in your life you have been “spurred on” by someone close to you. How did you feel? Was it easy for you to receive that type of encouragement? How do you need to change and grow so that you will be more and more open to be “spurred on” by others?
3. Who are the people in your life who know you well enough to encourage you? Do they have permission to do so even if it will be hard for you to hear? How do those relationships need to grow so that others can encourage you, or what new relationships do you need to develop so it can happen?
4. How will you move beyond Sunday to these types of relationships with one another? Are you involved in anything currently that fosters regular relationship with others who are headed in the same direction as you? If not, this week, what do you need to get more information about, or what do you need to get involved in which will allow that to happen in your life?
